Remaining areas of the Park could and should now be open. We expect owners Lafarge Tarmac and Hertfordshire County Council, parties to the 1979 legal agreement for delivery of the Country Park, to ensure prompt delivery of public access to the full Country Park. We are joined by Kate Ashbrook, General Secretary of the Open Spaces Society, which celebrates its 150th anniversary this year. After our 11am gathering Friend's Guides will take you through the unopened areas of the Country Park, to see the 600 year old Panshanger Great Oak, the Orangery and the views across Repton's Broadwater.
